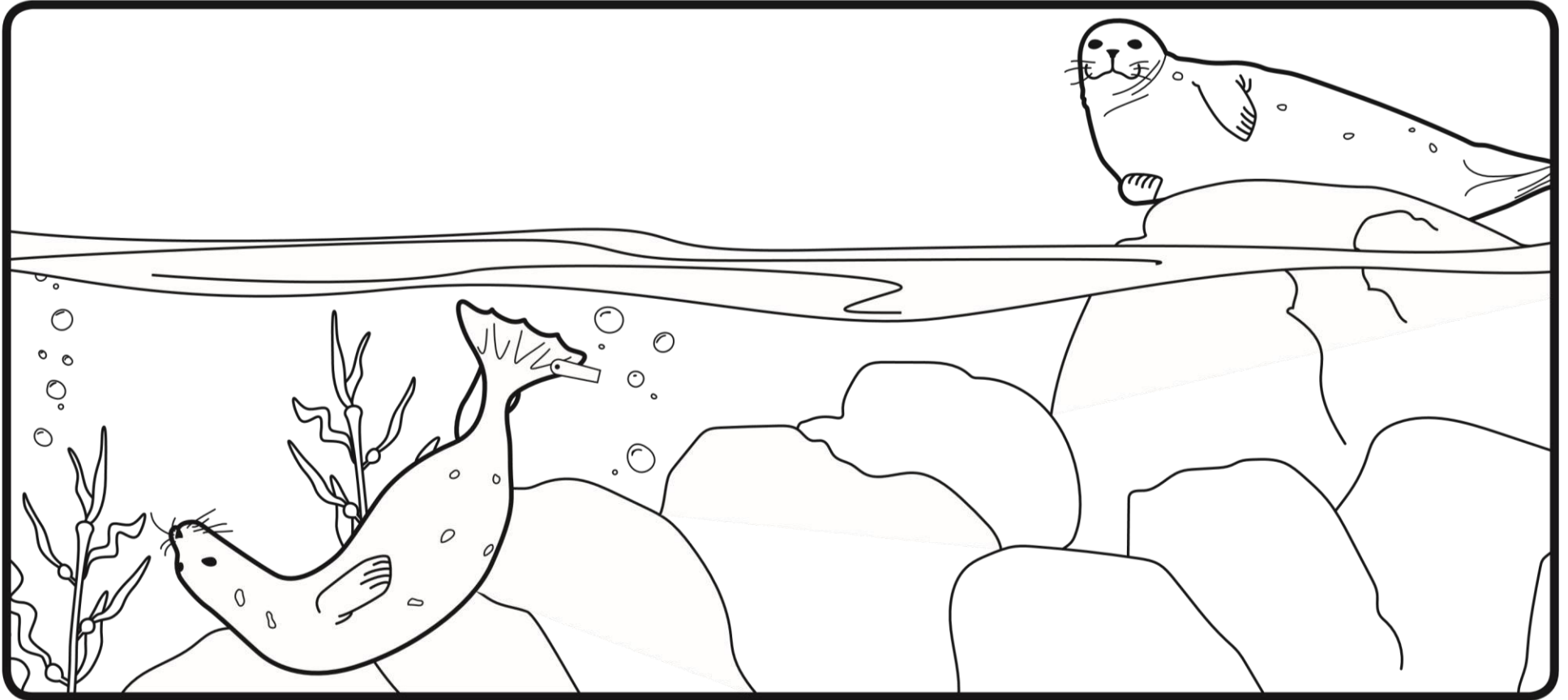


Harbour seal

Fast Facts

1. Individual harbour seals have different spot patterns on their fur. Add your own pattern of spots to these seals.
2. Harbour seals use their whiskers to search for food, such as fish, octopus, crabs and clams underwater. How do you find your food?
3. The Vancouver Aquarium's Marine Mammal Rescue Centre rescues, rehabilitates and releases over 100 harbour seals every year. Can you spot a tag on one of the seals above? The tags help researchers track where the seals go after they're released.
